

CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

Inside Out Programs is dedicated to providing outstanding sleepaway camp experience for youth ages 12-15 years old. Campers are expected to behave appropriately and promote a safe, fun and healthy environment through productive participation. The staff will use a positive approach to discipline and use parental support to resolve behavior issues and to encourage positive behavior. Participants who remain disruptive after consultation with the parents may be dismissed from the program with no refund.

Please review the Code of Conduct below with your child so that he/she fully understands the expectations.

As a camper, I am expected to:

- Show respect to other participants, and treat them as well as I would like to be treated.
- Show respect to staff and cooperate fully with following their instructions.
- Know and follow the rules of the camp.
- Respect the rights and beliefs of others and treat others with courtesy and consideration.
- Communicate in an appropriate manner, which means I must not use foul language or gestures, harsh words or tone of voice.
- Conduct myself responsibly. I understand that horseplay, unwelcomed teasing or other unkind behaviors are not allowed.
- Refrain from deliberately causing bodily harm to other participants or staff. I understand that pushing, kicking, hitting or fighting are not acceptable and will not be tolerated.
- Use program equipment, supplies, and facilities properly.
- Respect the property of others.
- Be fully responsible for my actions and understand that irresponsible behavior will result in disciplinary action, including but not limited to, removal from certain activities or camp in general.
